



## Environmental & Supplier Responsibility Policy Version 2025-2026

### 1. Environmental Management

ACME integrates environmental considerations into both administrative and operational activities.

Key areas include:

- Reduction of paper consumption through digital systems
- Energy-conscious office management
- Waste reduction and responsible disposal
- Monitoring and reduction of resource use
- Promotion of sustainable mobility where feasible

### 2. Biodiversity & Wildlife Protection

ACME prohibits activities that involve wildlife exploitation or environmental degradation. Excursions are screened to ensure compliance with local regulations and responsible tourism standards.

### 3. Supplier Standards

Suppliers are selected based on:

- Legal compliance
- Labour standards adherence
- Environmental responsibility
- Operational safety

Long-term partnerships are prioritised.

### 4. Monitoring & Evaluation

Supplier performance is reviewed periodically. Non-compliance may result in corrective action or termination of cooperation.

### 5. Continuous Improvement

Environmental and supplier practices are reviewed annually as part of the Sustainability Roadmap.
