



Sustainable Transport and Advisory Policy

1. Purpose

The company promotes sustainable travel across all stages of a client's journey, including airport transfers, long-distance travel, local transfers, and excursions, balancing environmental impact with comfort, convenience, and cost.

2. Legal Compliance

The company complies with:

- National Urban Transport Policy (NUTP), 2006
- Auto Fuel Policy, 2003
- Delhi Electric Vehicle Policy, 2020

3. Transfers to Departure Airport

- Airport transfers are treated as a measurable leg of the journey.
- Sustainable options (trains, buses, shared transfers) are prioritized; short-distance connecting flights and private vehicles are avoided when feasible.
- CO₂ emissions are monitored where possible to track improvements.

4. Long-Distance and International Transport

- Preference for direct flights over connecting flights.
- Clients are informed about airlines with environmental programs.
- Train travel is promoted where feasible as a lower-emission alternative.

5. Local Transport and Excursions

- Sustainable alternatives are always considered, including shared vehicles, fuel-efficient or low-emission vehicles, and public transport.
- Active transport (walking, cycling) and bike/scooter-sharing programs are encouraged.
- Public transport (metros, regional trains, buses) and community-based options (ferries, shared boats) are prioritized.

- Vehicles match group size to avoid unnecessary emissions; modern, efficient vehicles are preferred.

6. Vehicle Environmental Management

- Use biodegradable/non-toxic paints and cleaning materials.
- Extend motor oil/filter changes and recycle waste oil, antifreeze, transmission fluids, batteries, and tires.
- Use ultra-low sulfur diesel, high-efficiency air compressors, and clean-air technology in vehicles.
- Contain/reuse water from washing and optimize fuel efficiency (tire pressure, balancing products, gear ratios).

7. Client Advisory and Awareness

- Infographics and guides show CO₂ emissions for flights, trains, local transfers, and excursions.
- Clients are advised on carbon offset programs and responsible transport practices.
- Examples:
 - Jaipur-Udaipur-Agra: modern coach vs. multiple smaller vehicles.
 - Kerala: train vs. domestic flight CO₂ comparison.
 - International flights: nonstop flights and verified offsets recommended.

8. Integration into Operations

- Sustainability is embedded in itinerary planning, partner selection, transport decisions, and client guidance.
- Measurable criteria, vehicle management, and advisory services ensure environmental considerations are integrated across the travel experience.
